Get your sticky fingers on the Edinburgh Art Festival

Have you ever wondered how an exhibition gets put together? Well it's all a bit of love, and bit of luck in the hands of a person called a Curator. They organise exhibitions. Now it's your chance to be the Curator and arrange your very own exhibition using stickers of artworks in this year's Edinburgh Arts Festival.

Have you explored the artworks in the Festival using the interactive map at [www.mediascot.org](http://www.mediascot.org)? Or have you already been out and about to the exhibitions in the city? If not, no worries, grab your StickerBook and let's get busy.

You will need a StickerCurator StickerBook, a picture of the empty gallery at Stills and this instruction sheet.

## What to do

Have a look in the StickerBook and decide which of the artworks are your favourites. We know that big festivals like this are tough on little legs so imagine bringing all

your favourite artworks in to just one place. Think about what you would put in your own gallery.

Now it's time to get sticking! Arrange your favourite stickers on the picture of the empty gallery on the other side of this sheet of paper.

If you would like to test out your ideas first, ask one of the volunteers at the festival Reading Room at Stills gallery for a laminated picture so you can move the stickers around before making your mind up.

Congratulations, you're now a Curator! Take your picture home, add words or try colouring in the gallery walls. You could even cut unused stickers up, mix them up to make a new artwork or add your own stickers.
