American artist Allan Kaprow (1927 – 2006) has been described as an avant-garde revolutionary, a radical sociologist, a progressive educator and one of the most influential artists of his day. Known for his 'Happenings', Kaprow coined the term to describe his anarchic gatherings in 1960s New York, in which the audience became participants.

For Jupiter Artland, Scottish and international artists are reinventing artworks from Allan Kaprow's career, reimagining them for the extraordinary current moment and our new shared reality. These are not historic re-enactments of Kaprow's work, but unique and original reinventions of Kaprow's ideas and sculptural environments created by artists [Andrea Büttner](#), [James Hoff](#), [Peter Liversidge](#), [Cinzia Mutigli](#), Jupiter's [Orbit Youth Council](#) and members of the Wilson family. The opening weekend will include live works by participating artists.
