As the Union Canal celebrates its 200th anniversary, discover our commissions programme which unfolds westwards along the water from the city centre. At Wester Hailes, explore the Community Wellbeing Collective's *Watch this Space* in the main shopping centre and see sail-banners at Bridge 8 Hub created with local people in Pester and Rossi's *Finding Buoyancy*. Along the route of the canal, Associate Artist Emmie McLuskey presents a programme of new work inspired by the canal; and at Lochrin Basin, Edinburgh Printmakers present a new co-commission by Canadian artist Nadia Myer.

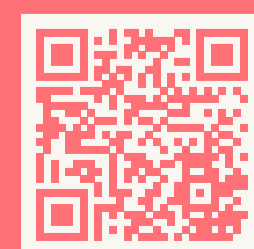
